A survey commissioned by Samaritans and conducted by YouGov

All figures, unless otherwise stated, are from YouGov Plc. Total sample size was 2138 adults. Fieldwork was undertaken from 30 November to 2 December 2010. The survey was carried out online. The figures have been weighted and are representative of all UK adults (aged 18+).

Key UK findings:

- nearly 60 per cent (57%) of people in the UK fear they will not have enough money to live comfortably next year, with well over a third (37%) worried about losing their jobs or having difficulty finding work
- more than half (53%) of the UK population says money (debt and bank balance) is one of their biggest worries of 2010, compared with 48 per cent in 2009
- 2010 was considered a bad year or the worst year ever by 30 per cent of the population – a rise from 24 per cent in 2009
- the fear of redundancy is widespread – 38 per cent of those in lower social groups (C2DE) and 36 per cent of those in higher social groups (ABC1) similarly fear losing their jobs or having difficulty finding work next year
- well over half (56%) of people are worried they will suffer directly in 2011 from cuts in spending on public services
- just over three-quarters (76%) of unemployed people and half (50%) of those who are retired are anxious they won't have enough money to live comfortably next year
- nearly a quarter (23%) of households with children are concerned that they may lose their home

NB: In some cases where statistics have been added together in order to sum up a finding (such as 'bad year and worst year ever') the statistic in the press release may differ slightly than the figures shown in the following data due to rounding up or down of decimal places. The variation will never differ more than 1 per cent.
