2021 reflection, a year for thanking our supporters!



What a year 2021 was for Sevenoaks Samaritans! Despite the roller coaster of pandemic restrictions, we still managed to end the year on a high reaching our 1st Anniversary with over 85 fully trained volunteers! The support within Sevenoaks has been truly amazing and we are so proud of our team who have worked so hard to get our operation running smoothly. Below are a few of our Highlights during 2021 where we have been supported and welcomed by so many organisations who have help us spread the word about Sevenoaks Samaritans. Here are some of our stats since we opened:

- Our volunteers have clocked up an amazing 13,409 listening hours
- We now have over 100 volunteers and we are growing!

- We made 523 contacts in the community from events and outreach activities.
- We have developed a schools programme and delivered an emotional resilience workshop to 6th formers at Sevenoaks School.

None of this would have been possible without the incredible support of local organisations. Our thanks in particular go to the following who have encouraged and supported us financially to provide valuable training for volunteers, helped us listen to people in need, and develop our outreach activities in the community.

Sevenoaks District Council were very generous in awarding us a grant to manage our operation and activities within Sevenoaks. We are also part of the hugely successful voluntary forum where we meet with other charitable organisations locally.

Oaks Blokes raised a whopping £800 for Samarathon during July, and our own team raised over £5,000!

Sevenoaks Business Show offered us an opportunity to network with the Sevenoaks Chamber of Commerce, and meet local businesses. We were kindly gifted our stand by <u>FM Conway</u>.

<u>Sevenoaks Lions</u> are supporting us with a generous regular donation to help us meet our operational costs. We look forward to supporting them at The Heavy Horse Show later this year.

Sevenoaks Town Council offered us the opportunity to be part of the Christmas Light Switch on in December where we offered families the opportunity to write a message of hope and support to anyone they know who may be struggling. We were also recently awarded a £1,000 grant to help fund the ongoing training of our Sevenoaks Volunteers.

Samarathon 2021 was amazing with our volunteers raising over £5,000, well done Team Sevenoaks Samaritans!
